

How to soundproof the elevator electrical distribution box



Overview

This type of problem can be easily solved by simply applying a layer of mass loaded vinyl to the walls in question. Mass loaded vinyl is usually about 1/4" thick and weighs about 2 lbs per square foot. This type of mass, when added to the walls, makes it more difficult for sound to. The best option for how to block noise from an elevator is either to add mass to the adjoining wall or to decouple it. Elevator noise can be a real bother. Elevator systems generate airborne and structure-borne noise, and meeting building standards such as DIN 4109 and VDI 2566 requires careful acoustic planning to ensure protected rooms remain at or below 30 dB (A) after reverberation time corrections.
