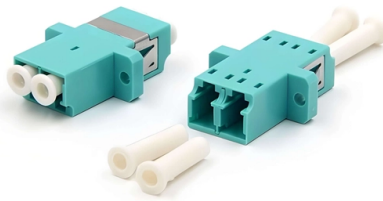


The function of the dust cover on the pigtail box

The Double Seal effect results from a molded-in circular ring in the connector, which corresponds to a mating ring on the lamp. The inner sealing ring covers the terminal area and the outer ring, or dust skirt, seals around the outside area of the lamp plug connection.
