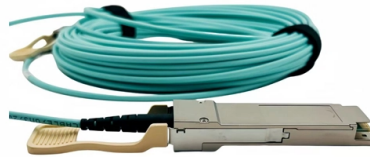


The pigtail wire breaks down if it bends even slightly

It's not too sharp for the cable itself, assuming it doesn't move, but with big cables that were bent after they were plugged in, there have been cases where the connector made any surface mount socket

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How to Pigtail Electrical Wires

Neutral Pigtail: Align insulation points, twist wires together, and secure with a wire nut. Redo if needed for a solid connection.
